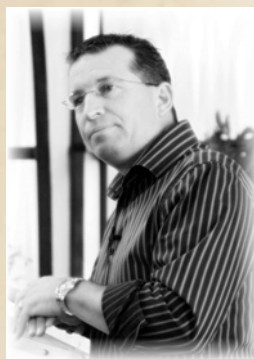
The rate is based on 2 people sharing a double/twin room. Single supplement rate available.

Expedition of Israel

Ezra Resources are conducting an expedition of key sites throughout Israel. This includes meeting Messianic & Jewish Christians and to observe the work that is being carried out.





Staying at premium class hotels; Tel Aviv, Jerusalem, Tiberius and Dead Sea. The accommodation is based on half board, buffet breakfast and evening meal.



Travel by private air condition coach to Masada. This mountain fortress was the stronghold for zealot Jews in their fight against the Romans.



The Expedition will take us to Caesarea to view the spectacular Roman Amphitheatre, Herod's Palace and to see the remains of the impressive Aqueduct that carried freshwater to the city from over 40 miles away.



You will spend time by the Sea of Galilee, visiting Capernaum the town where Jesus performed many miracles and healings. You will have the opportunity of going out on a private boat to experience the views that the disciples would have been accustomed to all those years ago.



Also visit the Nazareth village which is based on solid New Testament scholarship and the most up to date archaeology. The site gives a very good insight into the childhood of Jesus.



In the first Century a major siege took place and today there are clear remains of this historical event. After descending from Masada, you will have an opportunity to experience floating in the Dead Sea.



Of course a trip to Israel would not be without a visit to Jerusalem. Visiting key sights, including Temple Mount, viewing the stones, which were thrown onto the main street in 70AD during the Temple's destruction. Walk through Hezekiah's tunnel and visit the pool of Siloam. Due to the nature of the expedition, you will visit the Temple Institute and see how far the preparations have come for the rebuilding of the Temple.
